New Kent County, established in 1654 by some of the earliest English colonists, is located conveniently between the government and financial center of Richmond and the giant military and shipbuilding presence of the Tidewater area. The county consists of 221 square miles of land and water. With a population of over 19,000 residents, New Kent County offers a wide variety of recreational, educational, and historic opportunities for you and your family to enjoy.

**Academic Opportunities:**

The school year is divided into 2 semesters (4X4), with most classes meeting daily for the entire semester. Some classes such as Chorus, Band, and Advanced Placement, meet every other day all year or every day all year.

**Bridging Communities Regional Career & Technical Center Governor's STEM Academy:**

New Kent County not only partners with Bridging Communities Regional Career & Technical Center Governor's STEM Academy (BCTC), but houses the facilities for the five-county collaboration. BCTC is comprised of the following programs: Criminal Justice, Culinary, Diesel Technology, Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning, Nurse Aide, Pre-Engineering, Small Engine, and Web & Game Design. Students spend half of their school day junior and/or senior year taking college credited courses at BCTC and the other half at New Kent High School. In addition, programs offer industry credentialing tests that make for a more marketable graduate.

**Chesapeake Bay Governors' School:**

Chesapeake Bay Governor's School (CBGS) offers a community of learners the opportunity to explore connections among the environment, math, science, and technology in order to develop leaders who possess the research and technical skills,

global perspective, and vision needed to address the challenges of a rapidly changing society.
